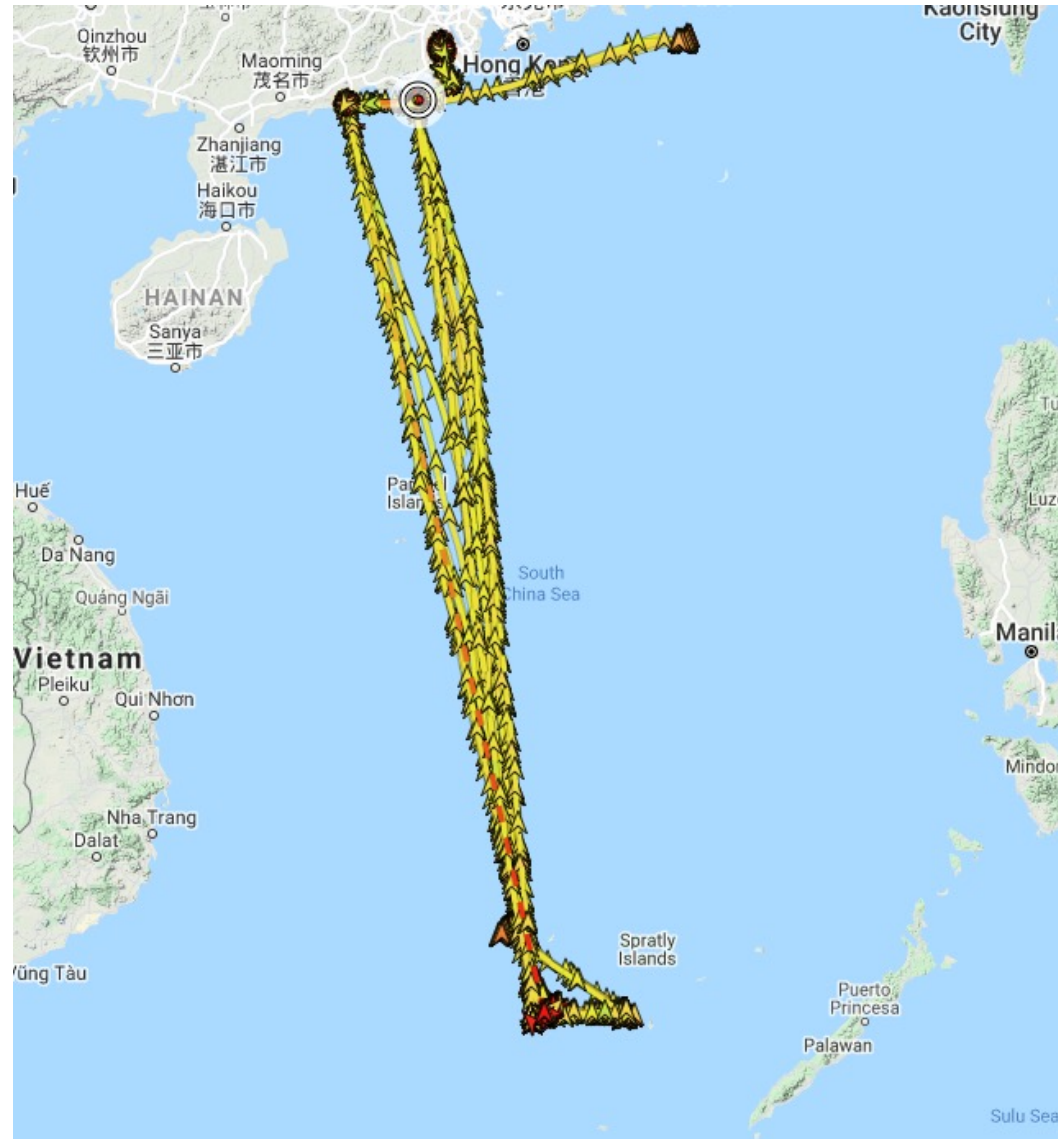

Shows the AIS transmission of seven squadron vessels from March 28, 2020 – March 27, 2021.

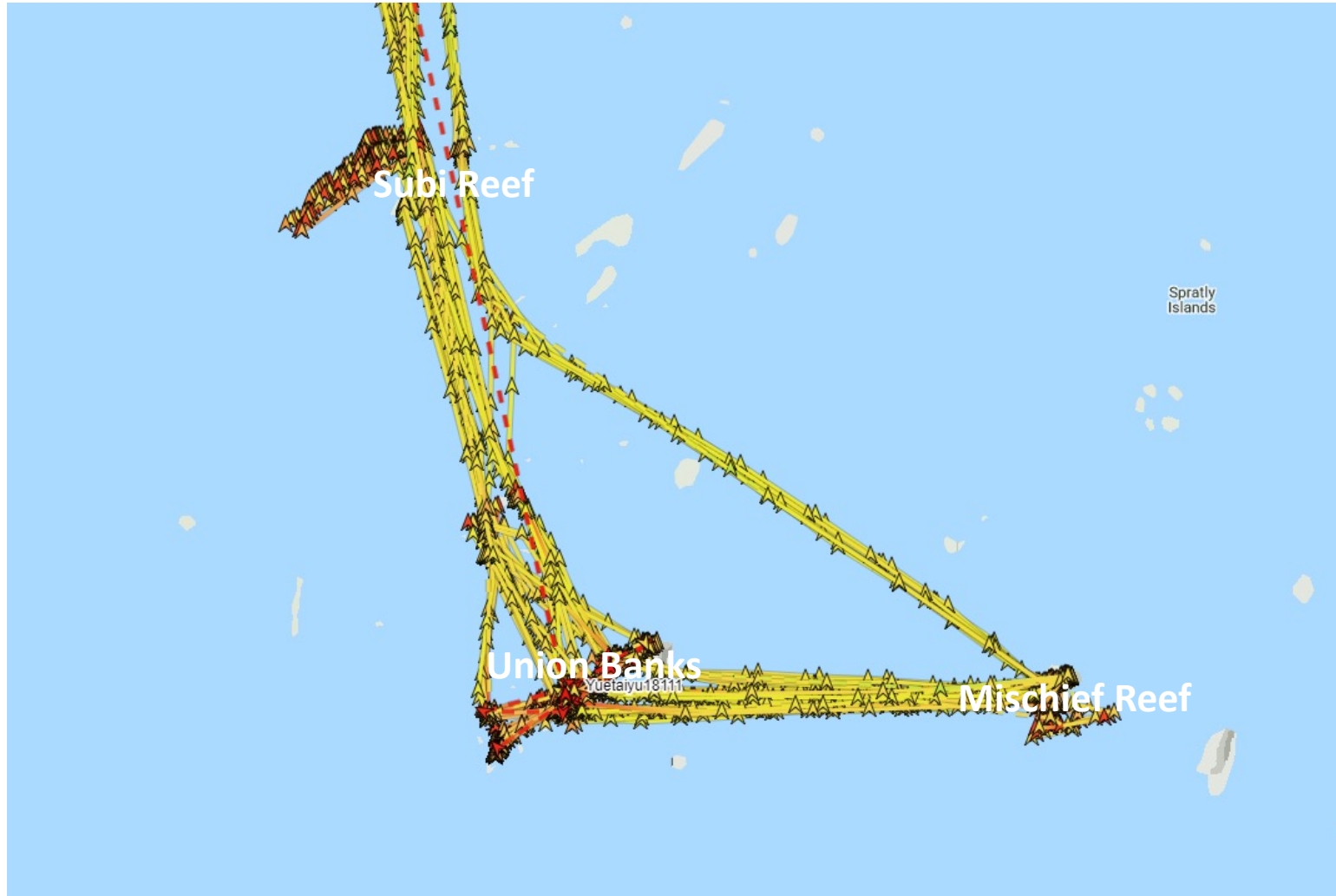

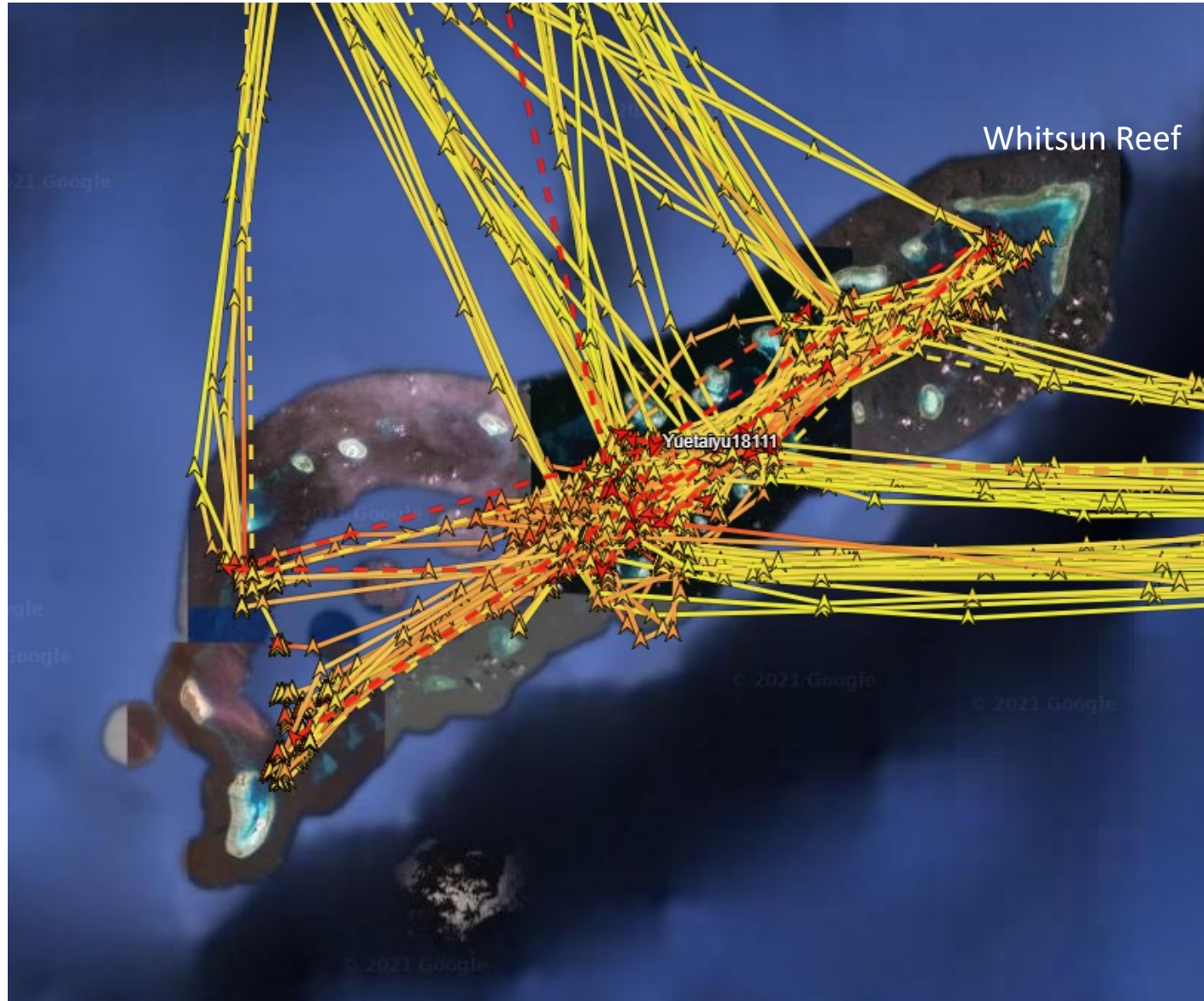
